The Principals of all Government Degree Colleges in the State are informed that Government vide reference read above issued General Rules governing levy and utilization of Special Fee fund in both Government and Private Aided Colleges.

Accordingly, the Department issued instructions on utilizing the Special Fee Funds from time to time.

During the recent past Government with a view to modernize the existing Educational system introduced certain job oriented Restructured/Vocational Courses in all Government Institutions accordingly, most of the colleges introduced the said courses. However, the students are facing problems due to lack of relevant material and referral books.

To avoid educational constraints to the students, it has been decided to utilize the accumulated Special fee funds for purchase of books and accordingly, the Commissioner of Collegiate Education hereby accords permission to the Principals of all Government Degree Colleges in the State to utilize the accumulated Special Fee funds to an extent of 50% subject to maximum of Rs.2.00 lakhs for purchase of referral books and faculty books to facilitate instruction to the students of the colleges.

The Principals are instructed to follow strictly usual stipulated procedure in vogue in the purchase of books.
